In 1938, a group of citizens formed the association which was initially affiliated with the Civic Music Association and brought in such famous artists as Marion Anderson, Kirsten Flagstad, the Ballet Rusee, Vienna Boys Choir and Ferrante and Teischer.

In 1957, the organization joined with Community Concerts to bring in such acclaimed artists as soprano Kathleen Battle, the New Christy Minstrels, the Indianapolis Symphony and violinist Leland Chen. In 2003, the association began working with Live on Stage, continuing to the present day, the rich tradition of superb, live entertainment like Hal Linden, Glenn Miller Orchestra and American Tenors.
